What is Esther's Army?

Esther's Army is based on the scripture found in Lamentations 2:18-19. The name was chosen for this army as, in the Bible, Esther boldly presented herself before King Xerxes and obtained favour for her people (the Jews) to save them from Hamaan, a man who made plans to annihilate them completely. In the same way, women across Canada are encouraged to present themselves in prayer before the King of Kings until they obtain His favour and He hears the cry of their hearts for the salvation of Canada.

In the words of Mordecai to Esther: "And who knows but that you have come to royal position for such a time as this?" (Esther 4:13-14 NIV.) We probably all agree that prayer is a vital ministry for such a time as this. Like Esther, we need to rise to the occasion and petition God for revival in Canada.

How Do I Pray?

Pray Responsively

Remain in a constant attitude of readiness for prayer. God may impress on your heart through the day or night to intercede for our nation. Stay tuned to the promptings of the Holy Spirit.

Pray with Thanksgiving

Always prayer with a thankful heart. Thank God because He hears and answers prayer. Thank Him in advance for answers and for the privilege of being a part of the Esther's Army prayer network.

Pray in Faith

Believe in faith for what you are praying for. Expect to hear reports of victory. Remember, God can do more than you can ask or imagine. He is the Almighty God.

Pray in the Spirit

Spirit empowerment is the heartbeat of our Pentecostal Fellowship. Initiate spirit-to-spirit communication with God, pray and praise in your gift of tongues. As the Holy Spirit prays through you, tremendous victories are won.

Pray Specifically

Use the resources and materials provided by Esther's Army to guide the topic of your prayers. Petition God for known requests, needs and concerns as they come to mind.

Prayer Focus

Before you start to pray and launch into spiritual battle, you must purify yourself before God and then put on His armour as outlined in Ephesians 6.

In Joshua 7:10-12, the Israelites lost the battle because of the sin of one man. God cannot use us if sin reigns in our lives. For example, sin such as bitterness towards an individual must be cleansed from our hearts. We must forgive those who have hurt us and ask the Lord to forgive all our sins, even those we are ignorant of, so that no access is given to the enemy.
