- **5. Provide a Simple, Step-by-Step Handout** Create a printed guide with clear, numbered steps (with screenshots) showing how to give online. Keep it simple and easy to follow.
- **6. Offer One-on-One Assistance** Have a volunteer team available before or after services to help members set up their online giving. Personalized support can ease concerns.
- **7. Make Online Giving Accessible from Multiple Platforms** Ensure your giving platform is mobile-friendly and accessible via text, email, or the church website. The easier it is to access, the more likely members will use it.
- **8. Emphasize Security and Trust** Many non-tech-savvy members worry about online fraud. Reassure them by explaining that security measures are in place to protect their information.
- **9. Encourage Recurring Giving** Teach members how to set up automatic giving so they don't have to repeat the process. This makes giving easier and more consistent.
- **10. Demonstrate During Services** Take a few minutes during a service to show a live demo on a screen or from the pulpit, walking members through the process in real time.
