Over the past few months you have been hearing and reading about **100 Points of Light**; PAOC International Missions' vision to send 100 new global workers to the unreached in the next five years. We have devoted two Sundays, April 29 and May 6 as a focus for this vision and we're pleased to note that many of our churches have secured a global worker to speak on those dates.

**100 Points of Light** encompasses three objectives for the PAOC. We want to **Celebrate** what God has done through our Canadian churches, our global workers and our international partners over 100 years of PAOC history; collectively we have a great God story to tell. But our work is not finished as there are so many who have not heard the good news. We plan to **Send** 100 Canadians of all ages and backgrounds to share the good news in places where there is little or no gospel witness. And, we are inviting our churches to **Give** towards this vision; our goal is to raise **\$1,000,000.00**. These are big goals, but if all our churches across the country are mobilized to participate, they are reachable!

And so, we are asking every church in our Fellowship to take up an offering on either of the **100 Points of Light** Sundays (April 29 and May 6); half of that offering is for your own church's missions budget and the other half to be sent to a special '**100 Points of Light Sending Fund.**' (<https://paoc.org/donate/100pointsoflight>)
