About the Role

The Director of Young Adult Ministry ("YA Pastor") will shepherd and disciple young adults (ages 18–35), including singles, young professionals, married couples, new believers, and those exploring faith.

• Spiritually mature

- Administratively competent
- Passionate about evangelism, discipleship, and pastoral care

The YA Pastor will cultivate a Spirit-led ministry rooted in FCC's CARE model, emphasizing relational engagement, spiritual formation, and community building. The role also involves meaningful collaboration within the broader pastoral team, contributing to church-wide initiatives and intergenerational ministry.

Minimum Qualifications

- Bible/Ministry diploma/degree and PAOC credentials are seen as an asset. If applicants do not currently possess a commitment to build a plan with the Lead pastor to pursue will be necessary.
- Demonstrated spiritual maturity, a consistent devotional life, and healthy emotional/relational patterns.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Administrative and organizational competence.
- A heart for discipling and reaching young adults, including those unfamiliar with church or faith.

Key Responsibilities

1. CARE as the Ministry Foundation

- Maintain consistent relational contact with young adults
- Follow up with newcomers and those absent from fellowship
- Provide timely pastoral care, visitation, and crisis support
- Keep an active pastoral contact and follow-up system

2. Shepherding & Community Building

Foster a safe, welcoming community where young adults can grow spiritually and engage meaningfully in church life.

3. Leadership Development

Recruit, mentor, and equip a diverse YA Leadership Team. Identify spiritual gifts and develop leaders in worship, discipleship, hospitality, outreach, and pastoral support.

4. Discipleship Strategy

Develop and guide a discipleship pathway tailored to young adults. Lead studies, prayer gatherings, mentoring environments, and spiritual formation opportunities. Strategically use Alpha for outreach.

5. Worship & Gathering Leadership

Provide vision and direction for weekly YA gatherings. Preach and teach biblically sound, Spirit-led messages. Partner with worship and tech teams to cultivate engaging services.

6. Integration into Church Life

Encourage YA involvement in church ministries, missions, and service teams. Strengthen intergenerational connections across FCC.

7. Pastoral Collaboration

Offer insight on YA culture, spiritual needs, and pastoral concerns. Participate fully as a member of FCC's pastoral team.
