GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

- Recruit, coordinate and empower volunteers, guiding them to deliver programs with focus on community and excellence.
- Train & develop volunteers to ensure they have the necessary skills to meet ministry goals.
- Able to preach on a Sunday morning 5 times per year.
- Other duties and responsibilities as assigned.
